GREETINGS FROM THE WOLF'S DEN

ADMIRAL BARBARA "WOLF" PAUL, ACADEMIC COORDINATOR



Or to put it simply, from the Office of the Academic Coordinator. I have just recently stepped into this position, and I'm doing my best to learn everything on the fly. I'm finding out there's a lot to this position, besides collecting Director & Dean reports & filing my AC Report each month. The AC is considered the 3rd in command of the Academy, and has other Administrative duties that go along with the position. These are the duties of this position. Be advised, I will be looking for an Assistant AC after the election, so if anyone is interested in this spot let me know.

DUTIES OF THE ACADEMIC COORDINATOR

All of the AC duties fall under this directive: To oversee and monitor the day-to-day operations of Academy. This goal may be divided into the following tasks, and may be shared with the Assistant AC.

A. REPORTING AND RECORDS

- Receive monthly status reports from Directors and Deans
- Assemble Dean reports into a monthly Academic Report that is sent to the Commandant, Vice Commandant, and assistant AC.
- Maintain an archive of all academic reports received.
- Inform the Administrative Assistant of Support and the Staff Member who updates the Catalog (Currently: Franklin Newman III) of any personnel or curriculum changes. This task may be delegated, but the AC is responsible for the accuracy of the content.

B. CONFLICT MANAGEMENT

- Settle disputes that might arise among the faculty, or challenges between a director and a student, if the Dean cannot solve the conflict.
- Try and determine if lack of communication between students and Directors is the fault of the Internet, incompatible servers, or dereliction of duty.

 Act as mediator if there is a breakdown in communications between the Director & student.

C. PERSONNEL MANAGEMENT

- Train Deans in their required duties
- Be available to all faculty and staff to answer questions about procedure, protocol, and other topics affecting Academy operations.
- Keep track of, and evaluate, the performance of faculty members, and make suggestions to Command for promotion, placement, or removal, if necessary.
- Research and suggest appropriate candidates to fill vacancies within the faculty by advertising on the SFI personnel lists, or from the graduate lists, with suggestions from Directors and Deans.
- Vet candidates for positions who apply to Academy from the general membership, and send them to the appropriate Deans and Directors. Vetting would include the following: checking the candidate's membership status, and what courses have been taken that are required for the position, and those courses taken that indicate a candidate's interests; check Bad Boy list and other outside information about nature & conduct of applicant; and check criminal records and other profile lists.
- Present vetted candidates to Command for approval.
- Suggest personnel and curriculum changes for the good of Academy to Command for consideration.

D. CURRICULUM MANAGEMENT

• Evaluate the amount of activity of the Courses/Colleges to determine if they should be retired or allowed more time to prove themselves. The 3 & 3 rule (Minimum of 3 graduates in three years) is used to accomplish this.

• Present changes in Academy organization to the CDC for discussion and approval, amendment, or denial. An example would be the Merge & Purge (Combining or closing colleges).

E. DATABASE MANAGEMENT

Inform support if access needs to be removed from the control of the person leaving. One such situation would be if a Director left, and his access had to be removed immediately. The DB must be protected from unauthorized entry, so no one may be assigned any course unless a member of the faculty or staff.

- Check that Colleges and Courses are entered, sorted, and assigned correctly on the SFA website. In most cases, the Deans are to do the data entry, but some Deans may not be comfortable with the database, so the AC must do it.
- All database changes need to be sent up to SFA Services in a work order.

F. COMMUNICATIONS MANAGEMENT

- Keepthefacultyinformedonprocedures, news, and changes on the Academy Yahoo Group and the Deans Yahoo Group
- Keep Support and Command informed of personnel and curriculum changes, so that their lists & their respective documents may be updated.

G. OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES DEVELOPMENT

- Advise Command of problems with operational procedures that need addressing (See SAOC Manual)
- Offer advice to Command when asked.
- Participate in, or initiate, brainstorming sessions to improve Academy operations.
- Suggest changes in operational procedures for the SAOC manuals for upload onto the Academy website.

As you can see it's a pretty involved position.

Something I have discussed with Carol Thompson, and I'd like to see implemented, is the use of the Chain-of-command. When utilized, as it is meant to be used, it helps with resolutions of issues in a much faster manner. We were always told in the military to handle things at the lowest level possible, and pass it up only when needed. What this means is that the Directors need to handle things between themselves & their students when possible. If it needs to go further, the Director should take it to their Dean for resolution. If the Dean can't resolve it, then it comes to me.

Another area that we need to work on is the need for Directors to have an Assistant Director. We have numerous schools without assistants at this time. What this means is that should the Director be down or out of the picture for whatever reason, and there's no Assistant, then the Dean will need to slide into that slot & run the school until such time as the Director returns or a new Director is picked. This puts an extra burden on the Dean that doesn't need to be there. Also, Directors with assistants need to make sure their assistants have the same files as they have. This includes an up to date course record. So, what I'd like to do here is have all you Directors send your Assistants copies of all your exams, manuals, and answer keys, along with a current course record. Also, each month when you send your reports in, include a copy of your course record with it.

Also, it's imperative that your Dean, Carol Thompson, Franklin Newman III, and myself have copies of everything in your files you want backed up, in the event your computer goes Tango Uniform (Tail Up) or is damaged and everything is lost. You can contact your Dean first (remember the chain of command) to get these files sent to you. If all goes according to plans, you should be up and running with 24 to 48 hours or less.

iAcademy Moving Forward with Moodle

By now you have all heard that a new website for the Academy is under construction and you have probably heard the term "Moodle" being used in conjunction with this topic. But just what is this Moodle and how will it help the Academy?

According to Google, Moodle is defined as a "(Modular Object-Oriented Dynamic Learning Environment) and is a free, open-source, learning management system or e-Learning platform, that serves educators and learners across the globe. It is the most widely used LMS in the world and currently has over 68 million users world-wide (and growing!)."



Therewere several reasons Moodle was chosen for the core of the new Academy website. First, we reviewed several LMS programs both commercial and free and Moodle out preformed the majority of them. Second, it had the capability of being setup as a "stand alone" software and did not need additional programs to run it on our website. Third, it is open-source and has a HUGE community that is constantly improving and expanding the software.

Moodle and our website is being configured with both the student and the faculty in mind. There is a slight learning curve for the faculty when it comes to doing the things they normally have to do but we are developing a step-by-step manual for their use. Students on the other hand will find the site intuitive and

straight forward.

The new site will feature a built in FAC program that will expand on the capabilities of our current system. It is our hope that the Academy Directors will embrace the new system and convert more of their courses to work with Moodle.

Using the new program, our students will find an easy and fun way to access our courses. Directors will find a variety of reports at their fingertips and be able to see and track the progress of our students like never before. Additionally they will be able to complete maintenance tasks with just a few clicks and have full control over their course listings.

The Academy has a "Moodle Trailblazer" team that is setting up as much of the site as we possibly can. We welcome Directors who are interested in learning Moodle and will offer them as much training and support as is needed to make them proficient with the software. 

SO YOU WANT TO BE A DIRECTOR ??

Basic requirements are to be at least 18 years of age and have taken OTS and SAOC. Cadets at least 14 years of age may serve with an adult mentor.

To assume a vacancy, you must pass all of the exams in the College, or if a College of 35 to 60 exams, 75% of the exams. Colleges over 60 exams are tested out at 50% with a maximum of 50 exams required.

Assistant Directors must meet the same requirements as the Director.

To direct a College of your own creation, first check the College Catalogue to make certain your idea is not already being used.

If the concept is not being used elsewhere, submit a College outline, exam, and key to the Course Development Contact, Carol Thompson, at betazoid@mosquitonet.com.

Carol will determine where your College fits within the Academy structure and introduce you to your Dean who will lead you through the approval process.



GETTING TO KNOW YOU



It appears Trekkies will have to wait even longer before they can see the newest 'Star Trek' TV series. Per Variety, CBS has delayed the premiere of 'Star Trek: Discovery' from January 2017 to May 2017. A spinoff of 'The Good Wife' will take its time slot instead.]

that the series is set to take place before the events of the original Trek series, based on the lower call sign number of Discovery (1031, vs. 1701 for the Enterprise). The lower number seems to indicate a ship manufactured years before the Enterprise ever took flight, putting our new characters in a time before

Captain Kirk's crew started their own adventures.]

New details were revealed during Television Critics Association panel. According to EW, co-showrunner Bryan Fuller revealed that Star Trek: Discovery will set in the "Prime Universe" (not the J.J. Abrams rebooted universe).



CRYPTOGRAM

Admiral Patricia Lewis



Understand the way a cryptogram works. Most cryptograms or cryptoquotes are basic substitution ciphers, meaning that the letters of the alphabet are being represented by other letters. A cryptogram in Klingon wouldn't be any more difficult than a cryptogram in Bajoran, because the symbols act as patterns in the end. Find the patterns and you'll crack the code.

In general, look for the patterns underneath the letters. Try to disassociate yourself as much as possible from the letters you're looking at.

Cryptograms don't try to play tricks on you, however difficult they may be. In almost all cryptograms, letters will never stand for themselves. In other words, the "X" in the puzzle you're trying to work out definitely doesn't stand for "X" in the alphabet. Solve one letter at a time. It's unlikely that you'll recognize one mess of jumbled up nonsense letters as a particular word right away, no matter how long you look at it. Try to figure out the most likely single letter words, then carry that substitution through the rest of the puzzle, filling in as many blanks as possible with educated guesses, then filling in the remaining blank spaces.

Completing a cryptogram is a slow process that'll require lots of guessing. You'll weigh lots of possibilities and make the best guess at the time. If, later, that guess turns out to be wrong, then change it.

Ok, this wasn't a surprise gift. I heard about it and pre-ordered on Amazon.com. I thought October would never come, or something would happen and I wouldn't get my new Encyclopedias that I had saved for months to buy! I know this may be sacrilege to some, but I actually used my last Star Trek Encyclopedias (1994, 1997, 1999). And when I say used, they are covered in hand-written notes (gasp), and the 1999 version has split in half...sort, of... I would take a picture, but I know it traumatizes my husband every time it comes out of hiding. I'm one of those people who LOVE books. I LOVE holding them, bending them, cracking the spines, folding pages, taking notes in them, and dragging them everywhere I go.

So, I had been dreaming of when my new Star Trek Encyclopedias got here, I could start looking and trying to find information that was missed, I could add in entries from any movies that weren't included! Then the books arrived...



The very first moment was like trying to pull the Excalibur out of the stone! I reached down to pick up the box from where the mail carrier had dropped it, it didn't budge. I couldn't pick it up with one hand, it took two hands to pry it from the surface of my deck and get it into the

house. Wow! What did Amazon use to pack around the books that made this so heavy!? Nada! Not a bloomin' thing. I opened the box, and in it was a big thick slipcover holding the two mammoth encyclopedias. Did I mention this thing is heavy?

There are over 1,000 pages between the two books, containing just about anything you could want to know (except Star Trek Beyond). As I did with the Spock Logic Book, I heaved the slipcover over to my recliner, and nearly strained a muscle trying to get the books out of the slipcover (did I say it's heavy?), which the slipcover is a thing of beauty in itself, meaning, I've never seen one that thick and heavy...
